**ELIGIBLE PROJECTS**

1. Purchase of sporting or other equipment.
2. Grant towards the costs of membership fees.
3. Grant towards travel costs and accommodation for the individual grant applicant only (not parent/guardian etc.)
4. Purchase of clothing associated with the sport or recreational activity.
5. Other expenditure related to supporting the individual grant applicant.

NB. Grants can be for a fixed sum for a number of years if the Trustees consider it appropriate and each grant request will be considered on its merits. A supporting letter from a club, coach or doctor would be useful. Where the purchase of equipment is concerned READY will deal with the supplier direct.

1. Grants will only be available for a period of 18 months from the date that the grant is awarded. In the event of it not being used within the time frame the grant or balance of the grant will expire unless written agreement to an extension of time is agreed.
2. The maximum total grants per applicant in any year for items 1 to 5 above is £3000. In exceptional circumstances this may be increased.
3. We may ask for a copy of a birth certificate or other documentation when the applicant is 18 or over.

Any grant for equipment will be subject to the following condition(s):

1. The person or their parent/guardian if they are under 18 years of age will maintain the equipment in good working condition
2. Such equipment will always remain the property of READY and should it cease to be used or the individual grows out of it READY may recover it for reallocation.
3. Equipment must be safely stored away when not in use.
4. Equipment should be fully insured against all normal risks.
